### **Thrombosis and Hemostasis in Coronary Artery Bypass Grafting Surgery**

1. De individuele aspirinegevoeligheid beïnvloedt het risico op perioperatieve bloedingscomplicaties van CABG-patiënten (Dit proefschrift).
2. Het meten van onderdelen van hemostase kan helpen bij het identificeren van patiënten die een verhoogd risico lopen op perioperatieve bloedingscomplicaties in cardiale chirurgie (Dit proefschrift).
