# Teacher Professional Development Interventions to Promote Data Use in Education

- 1. Data use professional development interventions contribute to increased student learning outcomes. *This thesis*
- 2. In addition to the core and structural characteristics of professional development interventions, the roles of facilitators and artefacts are crucial for professional development interventions to promote data use. *This Thesis*
- 3. Characteristics of data use professional development interventions to promote data use determine both the effectiveness of the interventions and teachers' willingness to participate in them. *This Thesis*
- 4. Teachers with more pedagogical ability are more likely to practice data use. *This Thesis*
- 5. Considering the many factors influencing data use, there is a need for a holistic approach to professional development that involves multiple stakeholders, tools and resources. *This Thesis*
- 6. Promoting data use is not a one-time event but a continuous process of learning and improving educational practice.
- 7. Developing teachers' capacity for data use cannot be separated from developing school stakeholders' and their schools into learning organisations.
- 8. Professional development of teachers should focus not only on initiating and implementing data use but also on institutionalising it within their school environments.
- 9. Successful teacher professional development involves teachers in learning activities similar to the ones they will use with their students and encourages the development of teachers' learning communities. *The Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD)*
