## **Propositions**

Statements related to the thesis "Aligning education to societal needs: Evaluating social accountability in health professions education."

- 1. The measurement and systematic evaluation of social accountability in health professions requires the use of a programmatic systems-in-evaluation approach (this thesis).
- 2. Social accountability should be evaluated at the school service region level (Chapter 5).
- 3. Using population health data for social accountability can bridge the gap between education and society (Chapter 4).
- 4. Only through the measurement of outcomes can the schools be truly social accountability (Chapter 2).
- 5. Program evaluation models provide a systematic and practical guide for monitoring the progress toward desired institutional goals.
- 6. Data should be used to generate new insights and better inform evidence-based decisions.
- 7. Assessing the impact of medical education programs on patient outcomes and public health is a global priority.
- 8. Better alignment between education and society is key pathway to improve population health.
