1. De ambulante flebectomie is een veilige behandelingsmodaliteit voor (voet)varices. (dit proefschrift)
2. Indien het scleroseren van zijtakvaricose na twee pogingen niet succesvol is, dient men te kiezen voor een andere behandeling. Ambulante flebectomie is dan een goede keuze. (dit proefschrift)
3. De wijze van compressietherapie na varices behandeling is niet standaard. (dit proefschrift)
4. Ambulante flebectomie is een effectieve en efficiënte manier om veneus materiaal te oogsten voor histologisch onderzoek. (dit proefschrift)
5. Het ontstaan van hematoom na ambulante flebectomie is inherent aan deze techniek en geen zeldzame complicatie. (dit proefschrift)
