1. CRP is produced by diseased vascular tissue. – This thesis.
2. Serum CRP, measured high sensitively, is related to the extent of atherosclerotic disease and to future cardiovascular events. – This thesis.
3. *Chlamydia pneumoniae* infection can induce a clinically relevant hypercoagulable state in patients with atherosclerotic disease. – This thesis.
4. A short-term antibiotic treatment has no effect on cardiovascular survival and on changes in ankle-brachial pressure index in patients with peripheral arterial disease. – This thesis.
5. Time-to-surgery is an independent risk factor for pressure ulcer development and prolonged hospital stay in patients with hip fractures. – Rademakers et al, 2005, submitted.
6. Sacral neuromodulation is a feasible treatment option for faecal incontinence in patients with structurally intact sphincters. – Uludag et al, 2004.
7. Vacuum assisted closure should become the treatment of choice for chronic leg ulcers. – Vuerstaek et al, 2005, submitted.
8. Morbidity, hospital stay, convalescence, and costs after colonic surgery may be reduced by implementation of a multi-modal rehabilitation programme aiming to reduce surgical stress responses, through optimized dynamic pain relief with continuous epidural analgesia, early mobilization and oral nutrition.
