Trust and accountability in health care for older people

1.
To trust physicians in taking care of older people, transparency in the criteria, communication and arguments influencing informed consent and delivery of care in medical practice is needed [this thesis].
2.
Trust requires continuous and multifocused work, since it is never finished and needs to be gained and negotiated in an ongoing process of action and interaction at multiple levels [this thesis].
3.
To discuss matters of trust and accountability in medical practice, it is essential not to identify medical with medical technical acts [this thesis].
4.
Value judgments by physicians represent an intrinsic part of the decision-making process for older people [this thesis].
5.
A deliberation-based framework on accountability and trust implies a radical and paradigmatic shift: not controlling, but shaping and building trustworthy practices in health care [this thesis].
6.
